Materials Pack

20 x 17" pure linen twill fabric with pre-printed design.
Appleton's 2-ply crewel wools to embroider the design.
Crewel & chenille needles required to work the design.
Photograph of the finished embroidery.
Water erasable pen
Embroidery stitch keys
Stitching instructions
Link to a short video tutorial after the weekend.
